

Initial Borehole Location Based on Early Phase 2 Studies

The Ignace area is one of several that are involved in the site selection process for a deep geological repository for Canada's used nuclear fuel. The next step to better understand local geology at depth is to study core samples. This work is planned at a site in a rock formation known as the Revell Batholith, which was identified through earlier technical studies and input from people in the area and Indigenous communities.
